🛠 Seasonal Maintenance Checklist for Prefab Homes in Northern Ontario

Prefab homes are designed to be low-maintenance — but Thunder Bay's four distinct seasons mean a little proactive care goes a long way. Use this seasonal checklist to keep your home efficient, durable, and stress-free year-round.

Spring

- Inspect roofing, flashing, and siding for winter wear
- Reseal exterior caulking and weatherstripping
- Clean HRV (heat recovery ventilator) filters
- Test sump pump or drainage systems
- Wash windows and check seals on triple-pane glass

Summer

- Touch up paint or exterior finishes if needed
- Trim vegetation away from siding and foundation
- Inspect decks, porches, and railings for wear
- Clean gutters and downspouts after spring rains
- Service AC or ventilation systems (if applicable)

🐬 Fall

- Check insulation in attic/crawlspace for settling
- Flush radiant heating systems (if installed)
- Service furnace or HRV system before winter
- Clean gutters of leaves and debris
- Inspect foundation and skirting for cracks

Winter

- Keep snow clear from roof valleys, eaves, and vents
- Check backup heating systems or generators
- Monitor indoor humidity (ideal 30–40%) to prevent condensation
- Ensure exterior vents and intakes remain unblocked
- Watch for ice buildup on eaves and remove safely
- **Pro Tip:** Because prefab homes are airtight, **HRV maintenance** is key. Clean or replace HRV filters every 2−3 months for healthy air and peak efficiency.
